## **Copyright statement**

## **Data management and data protection**

The operator and owner of the website respects the fundamental constitutional right to the protection of personal data and when processing personal data provided by visitors to the website, it acts in accordance with the data protection provisions of Act CXII of 2011 on the Right to Informational Self-Determination and Freedom of Information, subject to the requirements of the General Data Protection Regulation of the European Union (the "GDPR" Regulation 2016/679).

### **The scope of the personal data processed the purpose and legal basis of the processing:**

### **Duration of processing:**
